#### **Anti-Bribery & Corruption**

BSJV commit to ZERO TOLERANCE for corrupt practices.

Everyone involved in BSJV's business must comply with THE PREVENTION OF CORRUPTION ACT of Brunei, BSJV business principles and policies and as well as Anti-Bribery & Corruption Laws that apply across borders.

As major operators representing the leading industry of Brunei Darussalam, we expect our Staff and business partners to lead by example in the fight against corruption and act with integrity to preserve transparency and fairness in our business practices. Our personal and companies' reputations depend on it.

The direct and indirect offer, payment, soliciting and acceptance of bribes or facilitation payments in any form is unacceptable.

You must not offer, pay, make, seek or accept a personal payment, gift or favour in return for favourable treatment or to gain a business advantage. You must not allow anybody else to do so on your behalf. You must report corrupt behaviour

Know who you are doing business with by conducting the appropriate due diligence.

#### Prohibition against retaliation

BSJV will not retaliate nor tolerate retaliation against any person who brings an issue to our attention in good faith.
